

- 2. Open your computer's text editor ("Notepad" for Windows.
- "TextEdit" for Mac). 3. Type your date/time in the following format: year.month.day hour:minute:second (Example: 2011.01.31 12:00:00Y) 4. Save file in the root directory of the pen drive (place the file

next to the "DCIM" folder, not in it), and name it "time.txt" 5. Safely eject pen, power it on, and record video to finalize the change.

I. Force Power Off

If the pen behaves abnormally, simply press a fine object (e.g. tip of paper clip) into the reset hole for 5 seconds to force the device to power down, then power back up.

J. Insufficient Battery or Memory When there is insufficient space the blue light will flash for 10 seconds before the pen saves the last files and shuts down. When there is insufficient battery life the orange light will flash for 10 seconds before the pen saves the last files and shuts down.
